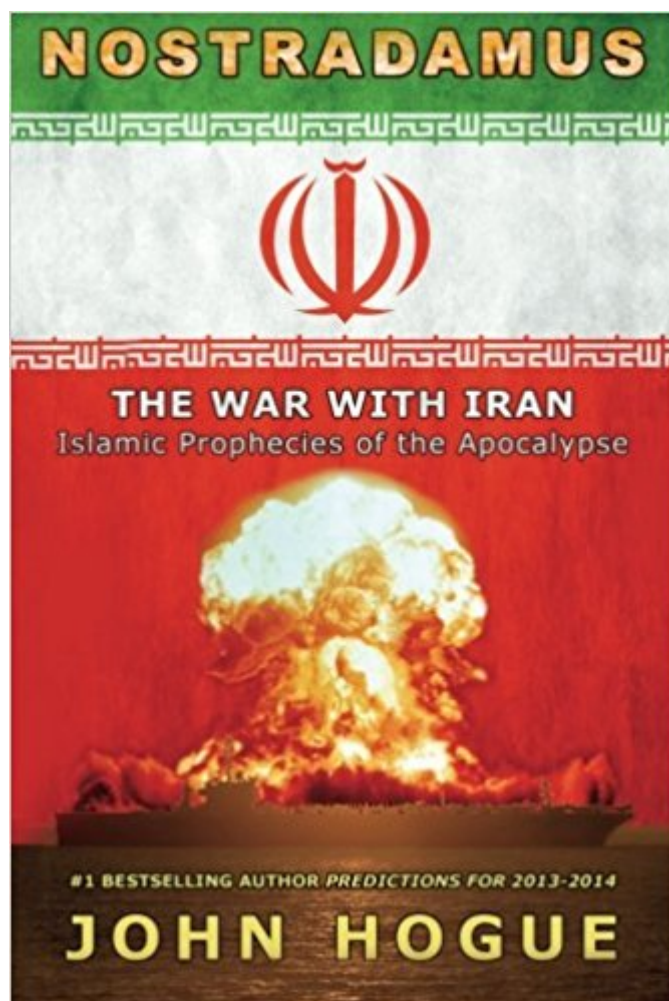


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Nostradamus: The War With Iran (Islamic Prophecies Of The Apocalypse)

As with another Hogue book on predictions for World War III by various psychics, this is a very scary book. The message is cogent and well-presented, hence the five star rating.
