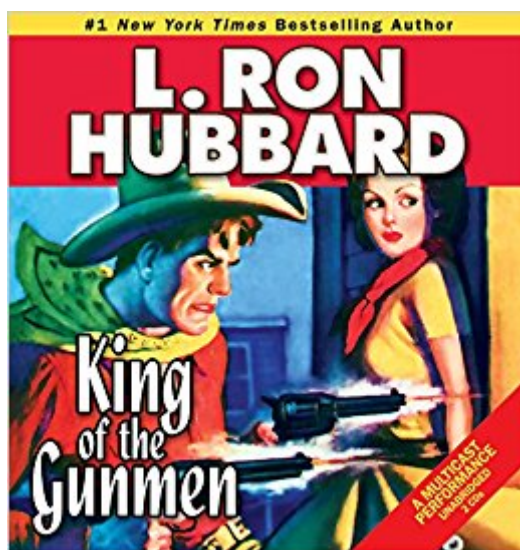


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King Of The Gunmen (Stories From The Golden Age) (Western Short Stories Collection)



Synopsis

He changes his name and his whole outlook, teaming up with a lawman out to bring the rule of law to this untamed corner of Arizona. But the two men are soon drawn into the middle of a bloody feud between cattle ranchers and sheepherders. Before it's over, the battle will lead Kit to a moment of truth . . . or a lifetime of lies. He'll have to take a stand and reveal that he's a wanted man or turn tail and run for his life, never looking back. Born and raised in the twilight of the Old West from Nebraska plain to the mountains of Montana L. Ron Hubbard grew up in the company of real cowboys and rugged frontiersmen, even becoming a blood brother to a Blackfoot medicine man. His firsthand knowledge allowed him to instill a grit and authenticity into his stories that made him one of the leading writers of Westerns, publishing a total of 34 of them by the 1950s. Also includes the western adventure The No-Gun Gunhawk, the story of a legendary gunslinger's son who swears never to take up a gun until he is forced to break his vow when it becomes a matter of life and death. Feel the heat rising off of the Arizona desert and a blazing Colt .45 as the audio version of King of the Gunmen takes you into the land of prickly pears and deadly gun fights.

But miraculously he survives and builds himself a new identity. Then a feud between ranchers turns bloody, and Kit's only hope of making peace is to reveal who he really is. Hubbard is at his stylistic best in this 1938 story.
