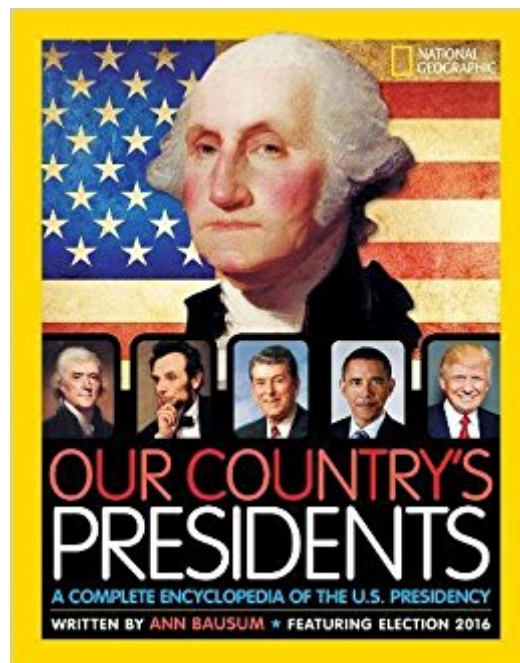




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Our Country's Presidents: A Complete Encyclopedia Of The U.S. Presidency
