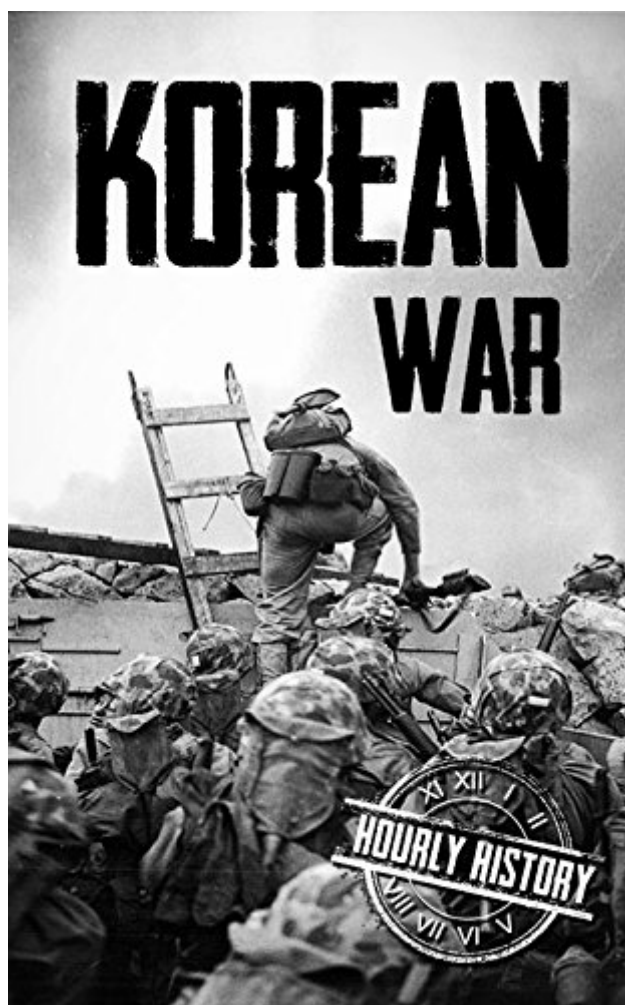


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Korean War: A History From Beginning To End

It was more like a high school term paper than a history lesson

I've read quite a few of the Hourly History books and this one gives more detail than any I've read before. There is a chronological listing of Korea and the war and detailed biographies of the main players at the end. I learned a lot I didn't know about this war in just a few pages. Highly recommended.
