

Marcus Battle cannot seem to catch a break. Just when everything settles down and he can enjoy life, Wham! along comes some Murphy's Law to turn it all upside down. It's been five years since Battle returned to the homestead with Lola, Sawyer, and Penny. They have managed to survive and come together as a family without much interference until now. Three men changed Battle's world in a matter of minutes. "Revenge is a dish best served cold." And, Marcus aims to serve it all three times. The Dwellers came into power after the Cartel was defeated. Their reign did not last long and the former state of Texas is once again a lawless territory with competing gangs plaguing the innocent. Battle's moral compass, or what is left of it, will not let him pass up a chance to set things right for those he stumbles upon. His search for revenge meets him up with the most unlikely companions. One tries to kill him and then becomes his constant sidekick. Another is on a similar quest as Marcus and joins them to exact his own retribution. The trio, while somewhat comical, are a deadly combination. This is my favorite quote from the book: "If these people could shoot, I'd be dead three times over," he muttered. Not sure why, but I found this hilarious. What Battle said is so true in this situation. But, I digress. Abrahams' fourth novel in The Traveler series, Rising, is fast-paced and gritty. True to the series' name, Marcus is always traveling. He cannot stay put no matter much he would like. The story is reminiscent of tales from the Wild West with vigilante justice and guns-a-blazing. There are no more hospitals to patch you up. You are more than likely to die from infection or bleed out from your wounds. I am enjoying Battle's struggle to retain his humanity. He often goes into the darkest places of his mind. Then along comes someone he is drawn to because they remind him of happier times in his past, and he starts that long climb back towards his version of normalcy. His story will continue. 5 out of 5 stars. I received this book for free from the author for review consideration. This in no way affected my opinion of the book or the content of my review.

I'm a big fan of The Traveler series and was delighted when I heard that book 4 was imminent. I wasn't disappointed either, and immediately got sucked into the book's dramatic opening. After his encounters with the Cartel and the Dwellers, Marcus Battle settles down to a quiet life at his farm east of Rising Star. Five years later, that life is brutally shattered in the book's opening scene and

Battle soon heads off in his quest for revenge. Along the way, he befriends a young girl name Lou. Tough, cheeky, and with a penchant for knives -- after a rocky start -- the unlikely duo quickly hit it off. It's not long before they encounter trouble as Battle searches for the men who have wronged him. Like all books in the series, Abrahams tough, lean prose beautifully conjures up the desolate West Texas landscape and the action comes thick and fast. More than anything though, it's the characters and the crackling dialog that keeps you turning the page. Can't wait for book five.

This series hooked me from the beginning. I was privileged to get an advanced copy and finished it last night. It starts off with a surprise and expands on the tortured personality of Marcus Battle. Along the way, he picks up a fascinating new character who does her best to steal the role of protagonist. You will fall in love with her. This book stands on its own, but I highly recommend putting it in context by reading the entire series. Abrahams has catapulted himself into the company of a list of great PA authors. Don't miss this one.

I missed this book when it came out, and am glad that I found it when I did. A lot has happened with Battle since the last book, but this book starts off on the sour notes that Markus Battle has become all too familiar with, grief and revenge. Battle is a survivor, and for many that get in his way that is a hard lesson to learn. Several new characters are introduced, and Tom Abrahams does as always a wonderful job with them. Tons of action, even better dialogue, and of course, Fifty. Definitely recommend this book, if you haven't read the first three, just stop and go back and start at the beginning; you'll get a lot more out of it if you do.
