

Morocco's northern half is shown on the front side of the print map and includes the cities of Tangier, Tetouan, Fez, Rabat, Casablanca, and Marrakesh. The reverse side of the map covers the southern portion of the country and includes a large inset map of Western Sahara. The Kingdom of Morocco is a part of the Maghreb region of North Africa that includes Tunisia, Algeria, Mauritania, and Libya with which it shares historical, cultural, and linguistic ties. Primarily a nation of farmers, the country is dominated by the Atlas Mountains that separate the fertile coastal regions from the harsh Sahara. These high, rugged mountains helped protect Morocco from colonization until the early 20th century when the French and Spanish brought their influence to the Islamic region. Every Adventure Map is printed on durable synthetic paper, making them waterproof, tear-resistant and tough • capable of withstanding the rigors of international travel. Founded in 1915 as the Cartographic Group, the first division of National Geographic, National Geographic Maps has been responsible for illustrating the world around us through the art and science of mapmaking. Today, National Geographic Maps continues this mission by creating the world's best wall maps, recreation maps, atlases, and globes which inspire people to care about and explore their world.

The map itself is lovely. The problem is that the very bottom of it sticks to the base of the tube, like an old picture adhering to glass, so it's impossible to get it out without tearing the bottom.

Purchased for my daughter and son-in-law, it wasn't what I was expecting. Disappointed, it looks like just an ordinary map.

This is an awesome map. Even my hometown of San Angelo is on here. It is hard to find a frame for since it is an odd shape, but the quality of the map itself is awesome. It looks pretty snazzy hanging on my wall. The letters are large enough to read but not so large it is distracting. The color scheme makes it look like something you'd see in a library, not an elementary classroom.

I ordered this map for a recent trip from Marrakech to Merzouga (Erg Chebbi) in the east of Morocco. This map was excellent in terms of detail and stood up well to lots of refolding. There are many villages along main roads that are not marked on this map, but they are also missing from other places like Google and Bing Maps too. I would still recommend that you have a GPS unit for trips in the east as many hotels offer GPS coordinates.

Received my map today via FedEx and I am disappointed. It was well packaged for shipping but when I opened the tubing and pulled the map out it was already torn and crinkled on the edges.

Excellent map used on Morocco road trip. Used in conjunction with Garmin GPS and Google Maps. Needed all three. Nice that this map includes scenic routes and gas stations. Nat Geo products are excellent.

This is a great map for anyone who plans on doing their own driving while in Morocco. First, it is plasticized, so it doesn't tear, and it folds up again easily. It is very accurate. It has the great feature of indicating points of interest and tourist sights in an easy to understand format. Such a good map that I will plan on purchasing it for any future travels where we intend to do our own driving.

We initially ordered another travel map which was out of stock so substituted this one instead and glad we did. We will be touring the entire country and this is a very detailed map which will most helpful in our travels.
