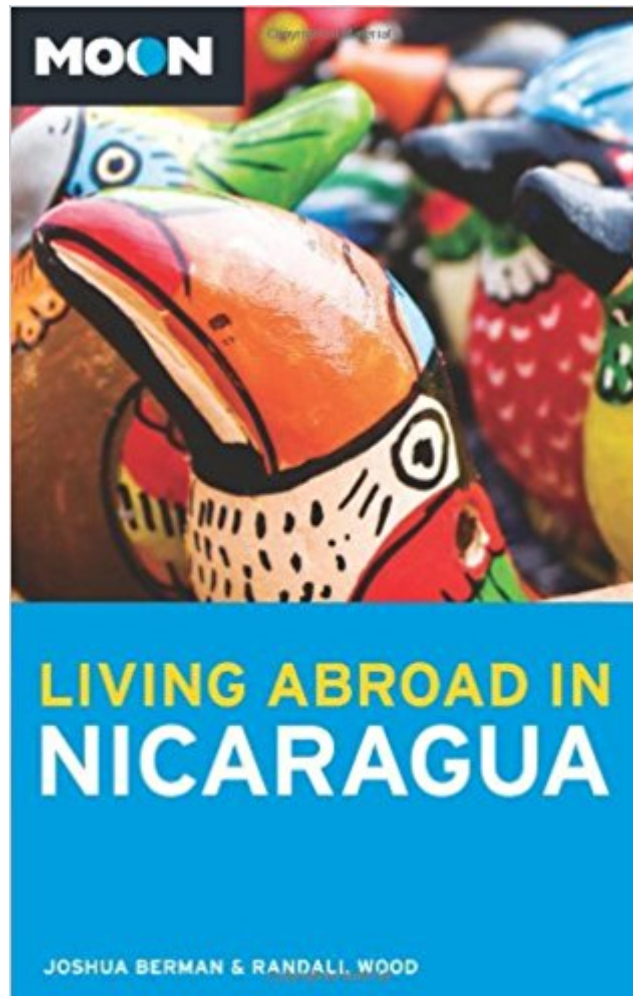

The author does a great job of describing what to expect, the good and the bad then follows it up with practical advice on how to create a workable life in these sort of places.

We lived in Nicaragua in the 1960s & 1970s, so planning a move back ... there are a lot of unknowns. We have visited for a week here & there, but it's difficult to figure everything out in a short visit. So, the Moon book is perfect! It gave us a great overview of the country & culture, differences between areas within Nicaragua, & basically how to get things done there. We will be
