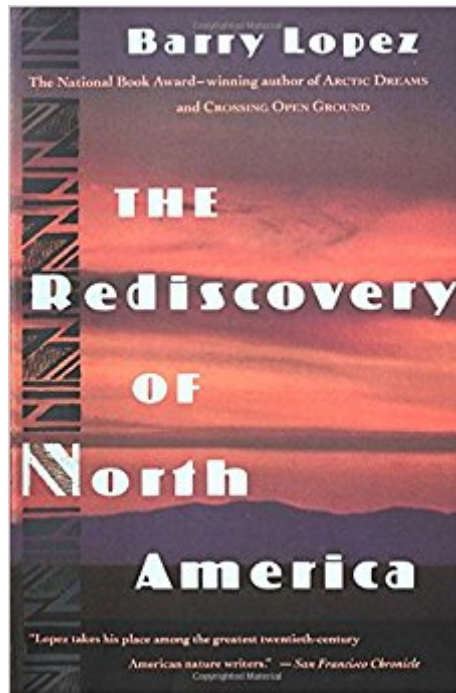




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Rediscovery Of North America

The message of biophilia, explored by EO Wilson, has not been articulated more strongly.

Two decades after the book was published, the concentration of wealth in the hands of the few has grown worse. Today the destruction of the physical world Lopez describes is mirrored in the slow destruction of hope in people.
