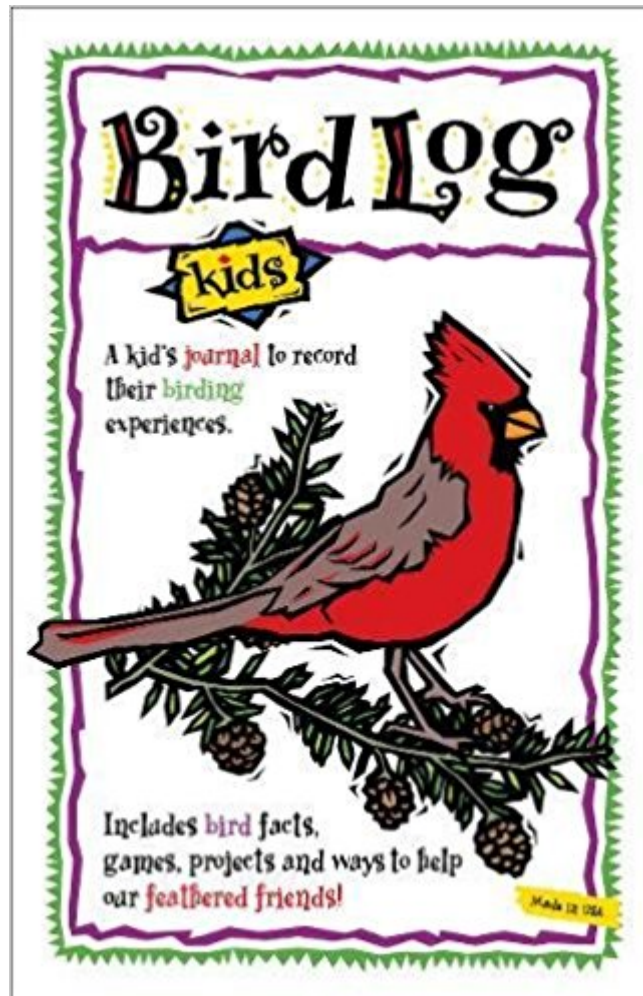

DeAnna Brandt is an artist and an author. She and her husband raised their sons in the woods, which provided endless nature encounters. Her Nature Journals were created out of a need to record those experiences. In fact, DeAnna's children were the inspiration for and first users of the Nature Journals series.

Our 6 year old loves watching the birds outside our house but because we live in Hawaii, most logs and books cover birds we don't actually get here. Our six year old can easily read the fill ins & fill them in. It has a place for drawing the bird too. I was really pleased with this book and highly recommend it to anyone who has a first grader or up.

Firstly, I want to address some of the negative reviews of this book. It is NOT a field guide, NOR is it being sold as such. As is made clear in the title, it is a journal for children to record bird observations. If you are looking for a book of bird pictures and descriptions, this is not the book for you. As a companion for a field guide, it does a good job of getting children to notice and describe features of a bird needed to identify an unfamiliar species. It has plentiful space to record observations and descriptions, and to add drawings, photos, or feathers. My one big complaint is that the life list section only goes up to 32 species. That may be okay if you are only birding in a small backyard, but I take my 8-year old camping and hiking and she is already well beyond that total.

These 3BIRDING books combine to provide the education any new-ish bird watcher could digest without throwing any of them in the blazing fireplace, and enough to make him/her HAVE inspired, intelligent, fact based conversations; OR, be the "GO TO" anything Nat birds, etc, person!

My 6 year old loves this. Each page has a list of questions like where you saw the bird, what was the season, etc. He is just learning to write and the amount of writing is just perfect. The questions are engaging. He's already logged several back yard birds. He likes looking at the tips and digrams in the book as well. It is very helpful to have a bird guide to go with this book as it doesn't contain pictures of birds. It's only designed to record info on birds already identified. We have one called "Backyard Birds" or something like that, which lists common species in various regions around the U.S,

Mostly just lined pages. Not much information or direction.

A perfect beginners guide to birding. Lots of "check offs" to prompt specific observations.

I got this for my 8 year old and it has been very useful, he uses it often. It is fun to write in all the

details of every bird spotted and it also provides good questions to guide observations. I saw other bird logs for kids but this was definitely the best.

I purchased two of these for my sons who have recently gotten into Birding! I like that it has a Life Log inside and also helps them to describe the bird they're watching. It's a great purchase!
