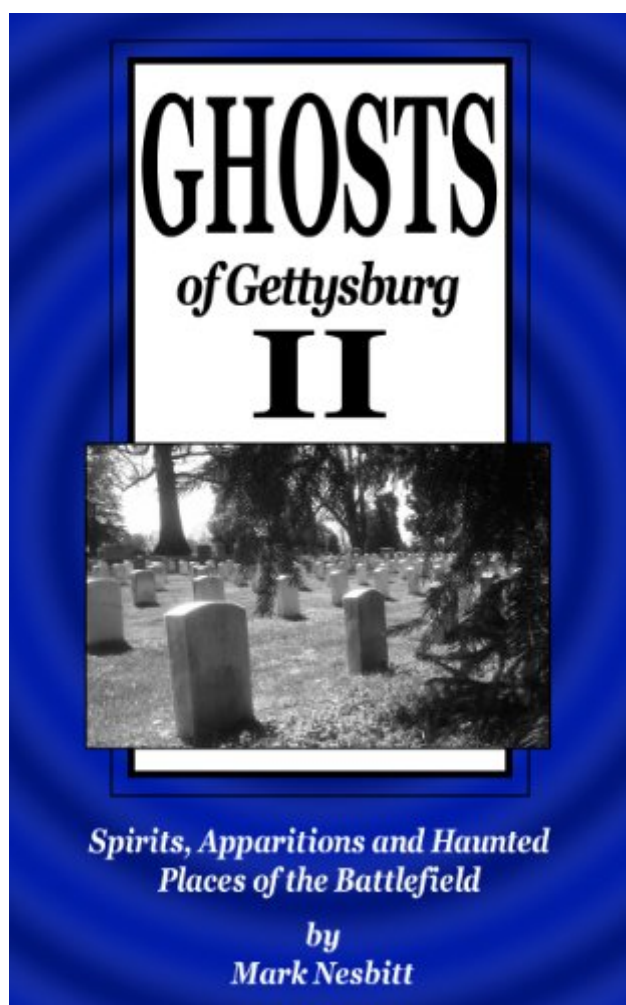

As long as visitors to the Gettysburg area continue to share their "ghostly" experiences, Mr. Nesbitt will continue to add to the "Ghosts of Gettysburg" book series.

The writing seems to be a bit more concise in this volume (not that the first book was in any way inadequate), and as expected, there are even more stories of fantastic phantasms and loads of fascinating factoids about the American Civil War to be savored in this delightful book. Like its predecessor, this isn't an especially long book, but it's fun to read and definitely leaves you hungry for more. Can't wait to dive into Volume III.
