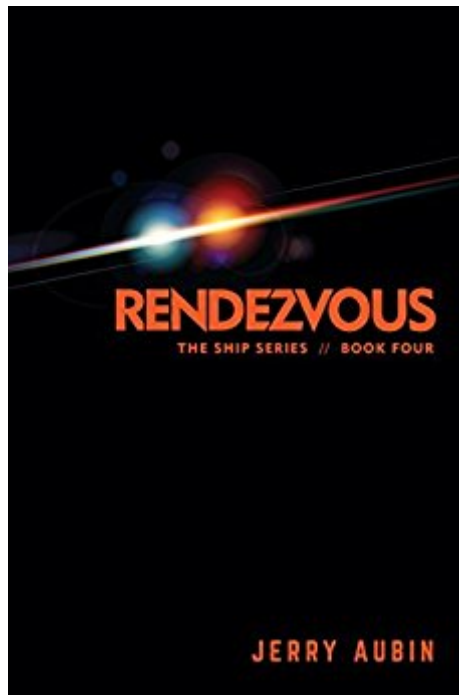

This review is for the series. Enjoyable, easy read, some thought provoking ideas. Mostly it is what I would call a sci fi juvenile, aimed at the young teen crowd and preteens. But the characters are interesting and the overall concept underlying the story are relevant and current. The characters and action are a bit simplified. Sex and attraction seem to have no role between 17 year olds, which

means it is definitely aimed at a young crowd. The origins of the characters, the way children are produced and raised is not addressed (at least so far). There's a good trend in the books to go from black and white notions of good and evil into more graduated ones. The society and its government become less autocratic but the story doesn't pretend that the problems that lead to unrest are simple to solve.

This is a series my whole family enjoys. Book Four continues the origin story of the Ship, and there are some surprises in store as we all start to get a picture of the current state of the universe for Aubin's humans. The story spans millennia as Adan's dream for and experiments with the remnants of human life "evolve" into the ship's world we have come to know through the first three books. The story is fast paced, and answers some of the questions we had about the ship, while opening up new ones that may be resolved in the final book. I wanted to keep reading, but have to wait for the final instalment!! highly recommend this as highly entertaining, imaginative, and just plain fun!

Jerry Aubin continues to deliver!! I have enjoyed all of the previous books in the series, and this book continues that trend. I think this is a new take on the genre, and Jerry continues to build and expand on it with every new book. I have also re-read all of the books several times (I usually do re-read, but not usually this many times) and have continued to find nuances and insights into the human mind and mindsets that are brilliantly incorporated. You can skim the surface and have a good story, and you can also dig into the actions and interactions of the characters for even more meanings and have a great story. I have been surprised how he has approached twists and turns, but it has only made me want to be able to continue reading the story. I hope that the stories of Zax and Kalare continue, but also that Jerry Aubin continues to write and share his imagination with us all.

Rendezvous is okay. I read it thinking it would be as adventuresome as the earlier books, but it was not. I think too many pages were wasted on Adan unnecessarily. since Zax didn't do anything with the information. I think Zax's behavior is not "Zax" enough since he hasn't done anything sufficiently stupid, which creates fun. Dropping Mase wasn't a good move as he has the computer hacking skills Zax must know he will need later. Kalare is a woman (common law wedded?) and has been for a while, and a CGA, so why bother with Zax? The Boss and Rege are still evil enough, but Aubin does nothing with them beyond some insults to Zax. The ending is okay but it took way too long to get to that point. I'm glad I read Rendezvous and would (and have) recommend the series to preteen

and young teen scifi readers. Vols. 1--3 are fun enough for far older readers. Rendezvous doesn't do it really as it is sparse on the action that brought readers to it.

This is another great book in the series and its all coming into focus now. This book was more about the early part of the exploration and how they all got the the point of the first book in the series. If you are a fan of the series so far of course you will enjoy this book but if your looking at the reviews and deciding whether to start the series or not do not read any farther, this is a great space series you will enjoy reading. I can't wait for the next book.

What a cliffhanger! Now I have to wait for the next book to find out what happens. I love the characters in this series and can't wait. It's like my best friend is in danger and I'm totally helpless. I love Zac and Kalare and had so many highs and lows with them. It totally threw me off when they went back in time to explain the beginning but it has now come full circle and along with Zac I'm so confused. Mr. Aubin please write as fast as you can. Can't wait to solve this mystery. Hurry! Hurry! Hurry!

The question remains hanging in space throughout the journey back to Earth: Is it an ashen wasteland destroyed by nuclear weapons or is it a pristine place for humanity to start over? The discovery of hidden archives show Adan to be a deranged mass murderer but will anyone in authority be able to stop him? We ALMOST get the answers we seek. Almost but not quite. Gotta wait for volume 5! And one more question: Will Zax and Kalare survive? And will they find love?

I started reading sci-fi in the first grade (ooh, 1958?) and have been through all the classics- Asimov, Ellison, Bradbury, Clarke, Brunner, and many more...lately I've switched my focus to detective thrillers and the like, but I tried this guy on a whim and I have to say its been a while since I couldn't control my reading schedule- I hit this hard from start to finish. Really looking forward to the next one!
