

I honestly feel sorry for law students who have to use this book.

This textbook is exceptionally awful. The lack of "big picture" contexts throughout the text makes it very difficult for a lawyer without a accounting/econ background to have any idea what the author is talking about. The definitions and explanations use the most convoluted possible way of defining each word and laying out each process. All I found in this book was frustration and confusion.
