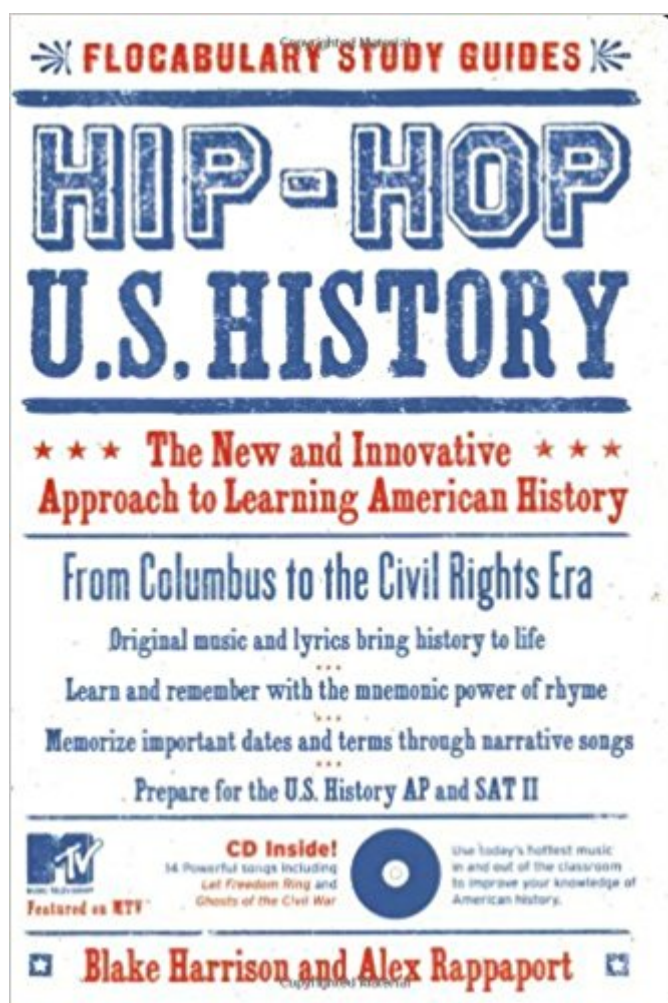

Okay, I'm a fifth grade teacher, so if you teach an 8th grade or Junior class, this may be for you. The CD and lyrics - while a cool idea - were too angry for my kids. I know there's a lot of sucky things in the past that I teach and talk about, but the music presented it in an angry manner. I liked that the lyrics talked about these issues, but wished it could have been in a somewhat different manner.

I used it in my High School History class, and the kids think its weirdly hilarious! They are definitely engaged in the content while listening!

This sounded like a fantastic resource. When I played it in class,however, neither I nor my 8th grade students wanted to hear it again. If they aren't listening, they won't learn from it. I thought it was too "hard" and loud, and, surprisingly, my diverse class of students did, also.
