

A fine example of why I love to read books by Nora Roberts. There is a romance and mystery, and a well developed cast of characters. The basic story here involves Emma McAvoy the illegitimate daughter of rock star Brian McAvoy. Emma possibly holds someplace in her memory exactly who was involved in the attempted kidnap and murder of her brother Darren. We get to see how this possible knowledge affects the adult Emma and puts her life in danger. We also get a look at her father Brian his band and it's members each with his own problems and ambitions. It makes for a great read.

In my personal library, I have over 550 hardcovers and paperbacks. Of those, at least 35 of them are by Nora Roberts and/or JD Robb. I got 'Public Secrets' early this summer and immediately devoured it. Sat down and - ZIPPED! right through it. When that happens, I have to read it again within a few weeks to see if I missed anything. Well, the only thing I missed was half a box of tissues! Make sure you have plenty on hand. You'll need them! And I wasn't content to read it a second time. I just picked it off the shelves to read yet again - for a fourth time! I have my personal favorites that I can pull off the shelves, open them, start anywhere and immediately fall in without missing a thing. Roberts' "Carolina Moon", "Blue Smoke", "Angels Fall", "Midnight Bayou" and "Carnal Innocence" are already like that ... think this will be another one.

Wow...just wow. To have a storyline span over so many years, have so many things happen...I really enjoyed this book. It had its up's and downs but I was hooked.

Always really like a mystery! The story began with lots of mystery and excitement about topic of story. Toward the middle of the story it became slower and slower and it was dragging by the end of the story. What a disappointment that was!

I enjoy Robert's books now but it has been years since she has written such compelling masterpieces as this one and Honest Illusions

This was the first book I purchased for the Kindle my kids gave me for Christmas, and if the typos in this one are any indication of the quality of a Kindle read it'll end up being one of those unused gifts that you keep sitting around just so nobody's feelings get hurt. Seriously, the errors are plentiful and run the entire gamut: punctuation, grammar... there are even a couple of instances where Latimer's name is spelled Larimer. Really??? Among the multitude, however, my favorite was when Latimer (or Larimer, take your choice) is standing in his father's orifice. Yes, his orifice. A page turner in typical Nora Roberts fashion, but the errors are unforgivable. 4 stars for the story, 1 star for the Kindle version. Atrocious.

Nora Roberts can really set up a tale. Spare, and not suffering from chains of adjectives or adverbs, Nora has me hyperventilating and crying all at the same time, finding it almost impossible to read on. She describes people and places perfectly, not too much, and just enough. Her character development is full and bleeds. Her stories are realistic and well-researched. Her plot and structure elements are as precise as a metronome.I recommend this book.
