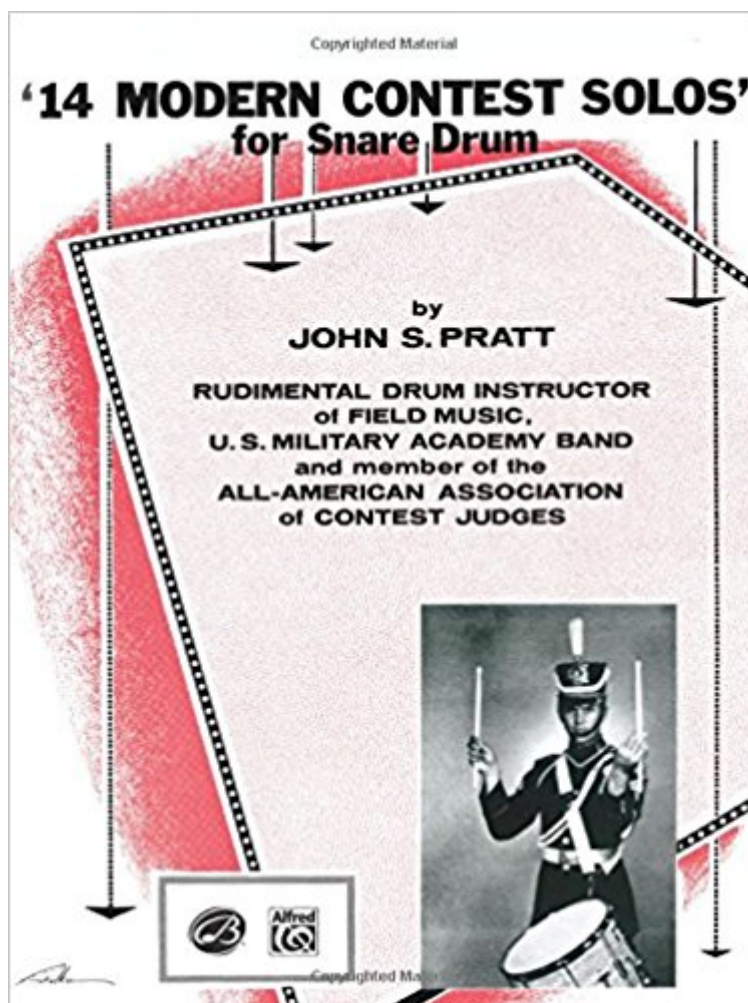

Really challenging and musical snare drum solos. To play these cleanly at the recommended tempos is not easy. Each piece has one of two moves that are very challenging, at least for me, and really identify weak spots. For example, I found that my left drag at the beginning of a right ratamacue is a little too long at higher tempos, so I had to focus on that to play one of the pieces smoothly. Working diligently on these really pays off on strengthening your rudiments and putting them together in different combinations

The phrasing used is great, a lot of "over the bar" phrases, and sweet sticking patterns. GREAT book, if you do not own it and want to work on your chops this book will help tremendously. These are not boring rudimental exercises like so many other snare drum solos, these are (again) VERY well

If you are looking for traditional pieces to develop your rudamental chops, this book is ideal. Solos are challenging but also fun to play. A true classic that is very helpful if you want to master the fundamentals.
