

Lonely Planet produce some of the best travel guides and this is no exception. Have used this one and previous editions over the years both as a visitor and while living there and discovered that there is much more to Singapore than just being a stopover or shopping destination. Singapore is an incredible city-state and this Lonely Planet guide can help you explore it and experience its full richness and diversity.

This book was the perfect guide for a recent 10-day stay in Singapore. It packs a lot of useful, concise info into a small book and includes some small, non-touristy attractions. The organization of the book wasn't always intuitive to me and some of the logistical info wasn't always clear - minor issue, though. A few of the items listed - in particular some of the small shops - were no longer there when we visited in Oct 2016. Overall, it's an excellent book and great asset if you're new to Singapore.

I think Lonely Planet series books are the best way to prepare for a trip to a country or city. I've gotten used to the format and can find exactly what I want. Unfortunately, if you take a book for

each country you will visit, you'll be carrying a ton of books. Best to study the books before your trip, make notes, and leave the book in your library rather than take it with you. A lot of backpackers photograph the important pages of the book and simply carry the information in their smart phones. Smart!
