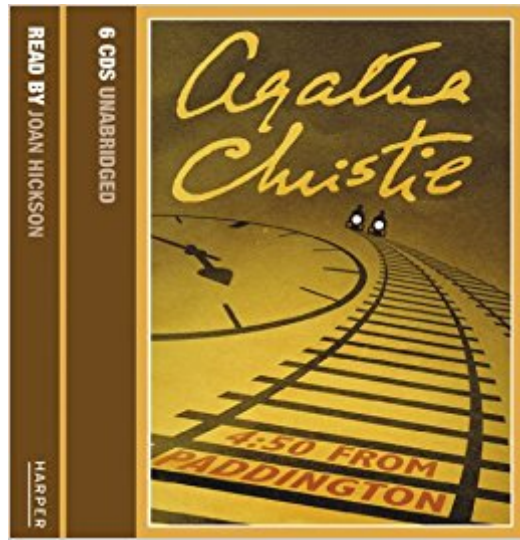

It is always interesting to note the changes made in the characters and the plot line between book and TV show. Both are excellent. Read the book first, however. As is always the case, a book can be more detailed and complex than a time-limited TV show.
