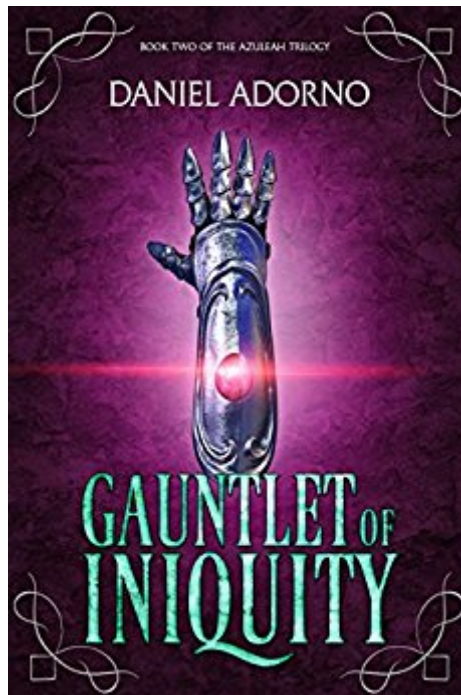




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Gauntlet Of Iniquity (The Azuleah Trilogy Book 2)

Helmer Silverhart was worried about his two sons when Kiret, a Protector, arrived late in the evening with news. His scouts had reported that the city of Aldron had been attacked by a dragon. As they were discussing this, another Protector arrived with news that something *ÃfÂçÃ â ÑÃ â œ* believed to be dragons *ÃfÂçÃ â ÑÃ â œ* was fast approaching them. While the Protectors gathered to fight, Helmer urged the elves to evacuate the city through the tunnels that would lead to safety. Continuing from where the Blade heir stopped, this thrilling book takes us readers on the on-going

saga of Lucius Nostra, his elf brother Siegfried, their friends Violet and Avani, Silas. He continues to bring Tolkien and CS Lewis to the mind of readers with the story line but he has his own writing style that makes him distinct and special. This book sees the evolution of Lucius as an intrepid warrior ably and fully supported by Siegfried. Silas has to assume the role of the king of Aldron because of the assassination of his father, an assassination with all its evil effects also has at least two good outcomes. One of these is the discovery of a vile villain who has been masquerading as a good man and an absolute change of attitude in another person. All these beguiling occurrences have to read in the book to get the full spirit of these events! The action is thrilling ; the experiences of Lucius after he has been "killed" in the battle with the soldiers of Memnon has to be read to feel that exceptional exhilaration that comes when the episode is described!
