

A concise, accessible account of life during this period and the issues specific to women. Chapter divisions provide easy access to topics of interest such as work, art, politics, and religion. Included throughout are examples of women's contributions including poems and writings from journals and diaries, and reproductions of paintings. Sidebars, shaded in beige, add information and primary-source material on such topics as "Regulating the Market Women" and "Women in the Military." They also offer a number of short profiles on individuals such as the pirate Grace O'Malley, the educator Bathsua Makin, and the missionary Luisa de Carvajal. The index is comprehensive, the endnotes are extensive, and the full-color reproductions and a few maps are well placed. This attractive title will serve report writers and general readers.
