

He enjoyed reading Encyclopedia Brown last fall and this book is similar in format in that you have a complete mystery and resolution in each chapter. However each mystery comes with a Bible verse to help you solve it. My son sat with his Bible open on his lap while I read the story and he looked up the verse and then tried to figure out the solution. I'm thankful for any book that can get my kids interested in reading AND give them opportunity to become more familiar with their Bibles!

My third grader enjoyed reading this book. It reminded me of the Encyclopedia Brown series, with short mysteries and the solutions to them in the back.
