Unless you know how to decipher a piece from a written description, this book is hard to figure out. I don't know the names of pieces and was hoping for pictures with prices and descriptions. This book is for experts in my opinion not newbies to the depression glass world like me.

Helpful guide. Mostly black and white. Few photos but enough to discern patterns. This is more like

a checklist than a browsing book.

I don't like to review a book until I have actually had it for a period of time. I have had this book for several months and have referred to it a few times. Which makes it a good resource book. My one negative is that I feel the prices are inflated. It was published in 2009. The market is not that much different now in 2013/2014 and yet the prices are a bit outrageous. If you are looking for good descriptions, this is a good book. If you are purchasing this book, to look for rough estimates - look elsewhere.

My wife and I have a large collection of depression glass and this book did a nice job helping us learn more about what we have as well as a fair price to pay on glass we want to pick up.
