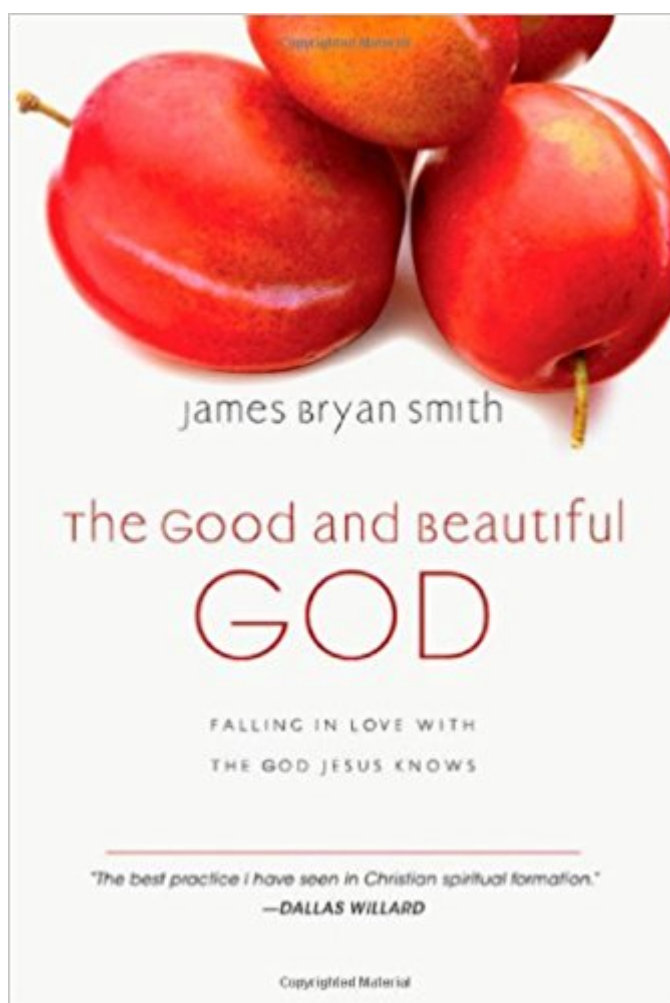


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The Good And Beautiful God: Falling In Love With The God Jesus Knows (The Apprentice Series)

The path to spiritual transformation begins here. Turning to the Gospels, Smith invites you to put your ideas to the test to see if they match up with what Jesus himself reveals about God. Once you've discovered the truth in Scripture, Smith leads you through a process of spiritual formation that includes specific activities aimed at making these new narratives real in your body and soul as well as your mind. At the end of each chapter you'll find an opportunity for soul training, engaging in spiritual practices that reinforce the biblical messages on your mind and heart. Because the best way to make a complete and lasting change is to go through the material in community, small group discussion questions also accompany each chapter. This deep, loving and transformative book will help you discover the narratives that Jesus lived by--to know the Lord he knew and the kingdom he proclaimed--and to practice spiritual exercises that will help you grow in the knowledge of our good and beautiful God.

"The Good and Beautiful God," along with the rest of the Apprentice Series, has quickly become one of my favorite series to recommend to people of all ages. James Bryan Smith uses language that allows anyone along the spectrum of the life-long Christian to an individual who does not believe in Jesus to better understand the heart and love of God Himself. Through Smith's articulation of people's development of "false narratives," the reader will better understand why God has been attributed such characteristics as "wrath," and how Jesus (what He says, the love He shows, and what He has done) rewrites these lies each of us have come to believe. The "Soul Training Exercises" (really, just disciplined practices) at the end of each chapter challenge the reader to continue to pursue the Lord throughout the week as he/she reflects on the teachings and love that God has for each of us. The best setting for reading this series is within a smaller group. I've studied "The Good and Beautiful God" in a group of three, and gone through "The Good and

Beautiful Life" with one other person. A smaller setting allows for a greater chance of accountability and honest discussion of the text, the Scripture passages that accompany each chapter, and of its application in our daily lives. Overall, I highly recommend this series to anyone that is seeking to better understand the love of God, how that applies, fuels, and compels us in our daily life, and how that translates to the community around us.
