

This is a lovely story about dealing with bullying. Young Tyler begins his day with dreading his walk to the school bus stop, since the other boys tease him about the way he seems to trip when he walks. His good friend, Danae, suggests that he give the bullies "a bug and a wish". Tyler isn't too sure what that means, but when he finds a ladybug and then a dandelion seed (which can be used to make a wish) he decides to see if it works. Then he discovers that that wasn't what Danae meant at all - but did it work? You'll have to read the story...This debut children's book, by teacher Karen

Scheuer, helps children deal with bullying in a unique way. It shows children that teasing can hurt feelings, and make others sad. The illustrations by Kalpart capture feelings beautifully and make the story a delight to read!

Through the pages of Karen Scheuer's book "A Bug And A Wish", great conversations can unfold between the readers, parents and friends about the painful subject of bullying. As Karen shares in story form the "It bugs me when...I wish you would" teacher-tested approach to addressing bullying, children are equipped to communicate firmly, respectfully and courageously to someone who is mistreating them. And as we see in Karen's book, disarming a bully can sometimes lead to an unexpected, healthy friendship. Beyond being an enjoyable book with lovely illustrations, the message of Karen's book gives children relationship tools that they can carry through adulthood.
