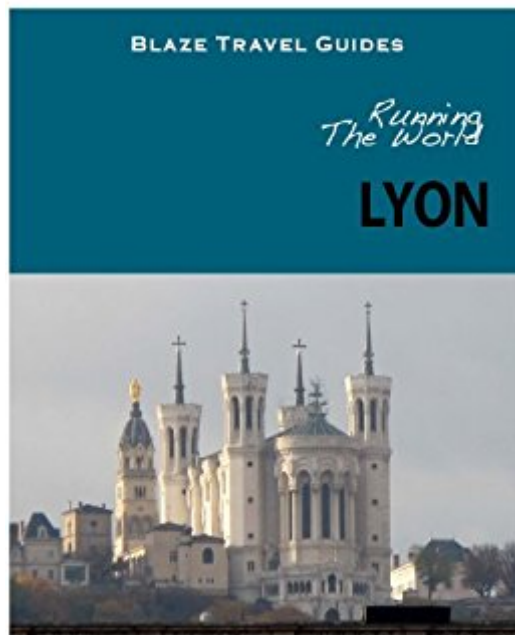

The book would gain a lot if the authors took the trouble to tell readers what to expect in varying conditions (darkness, summer, winter, what difficulties to expect, bonuses to expect if You continue running in some direction outside the
