

Great book, good price, all in neat print. I really enjoy the Planets and seeing how it's made it amazing (If not a bit terrifying). Jokes aside, it's a great buy for any fan of Holst.

This Dover score presents everything in a clear and easy-to-read way even though Holst wrote some interesting things that are difficult to notate by ear! The score does open up a new world - listening to it and reading/watching the score are two different things. I was completely unaware of Holst's gigantic forces and his wonderful orchestration that is present in the score. There's no see through on the pages (and where there is, it is only minimal). Main languages are English and Italian terms. For an 80-year old score, it's pretty impressive and in very good condition. A very good buy I must say for \$10 - my friend had to pay close to \$70 for her copy (both of which are exactly the same). A great bargain!
