

I bought this book to use in my Developing Logic in Young Children class. It is part of an activity to do with preschoolers. My students enjoyed it because it showed them another way to use books to help children think logically. It can be paired with a simple math activity.

Her copy's cover was missing and the pages were brown with age (signs of a well loved children's book). The story is so cute with a simple message; appreciate what you have. The illustrations are simple but descriptive and the expressions on the character's faces are spot on. My children (7 & 4) love this book as well. They enjoy all the animal sounds and like to look for all the animals as Peter's room fills up. This book has been a part of our family's library for 3 generations now and will continue to be a staple of our children's reading for years to come.

Get your 'reading aloud' skills honed up for the sound effects and prepare for multi-generational amusemen. We had this book in soft cover when our four children were little but finding it again, I can say for certain that the most fun you've ever had is easily found when reading this to
