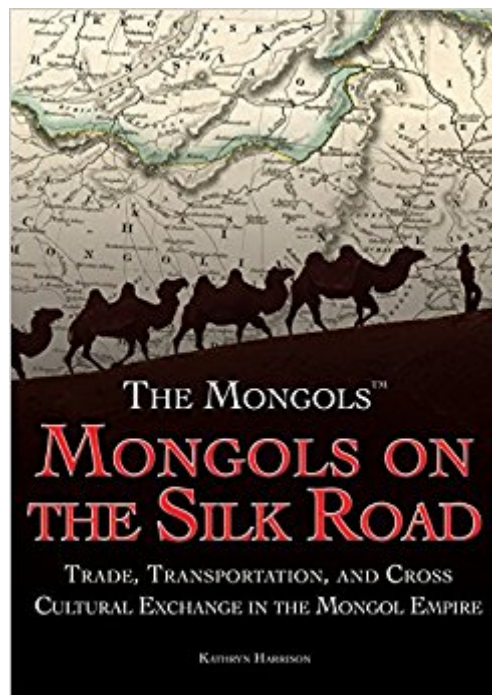




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Mongols On The Silk Road: Trade, Transportation, And Cross-Cultural Exchange In The Mongol Empire
